## Dear M embers of Congress,

As organizations representing medical professionals, the public health community and individuals who are immunocompromised, we have been encouraged by current vaccine-preventable disease outbreaks and prevent more from occurring.

Vaccines have led to the elimination of polio, measles and rubella from the United States. However, a confluence of vaccine hesitancy and access issues has led to decreases in vaccination rates and subsequent outbreaks. The 2017-2018 influenza season resulted in over 79,000 deaths, ${ }^{1}$ including 185 children, most of whom were unvaccinated. ${ }^{2}$ This number represents more deaths from the flu than any single season since the 1970s. As of April 4, 465 cases of measles have been confirmed in 19 states. $^{3}$
